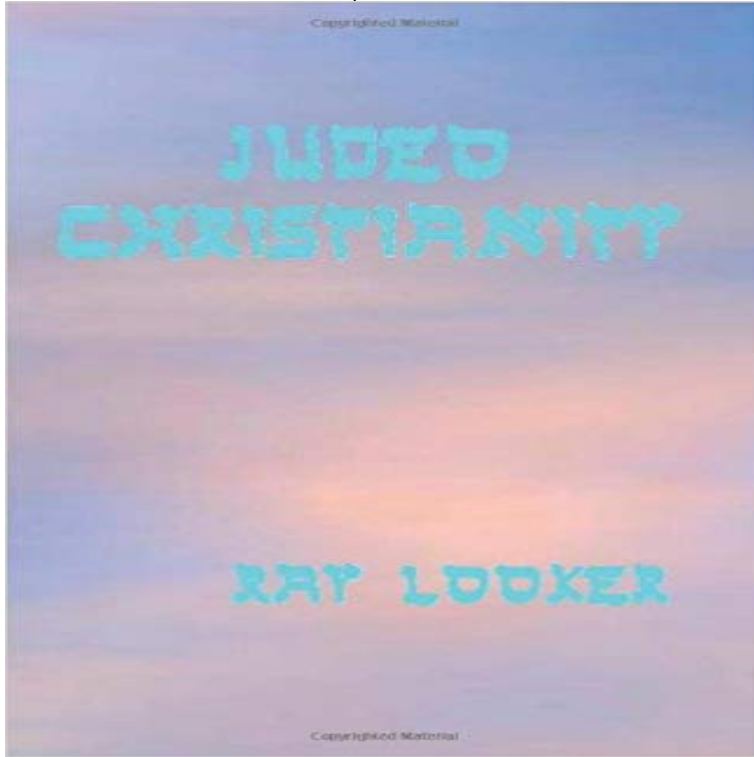


# Judeo-Christianity
