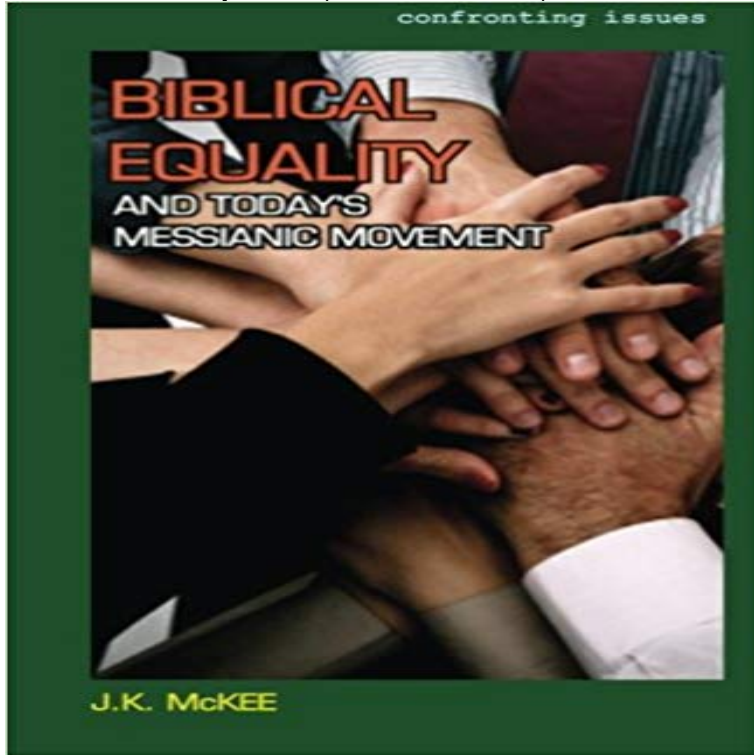


Biblical Equality and Today's Messianic Movement



Galatians 3:28 is one of the most important verses not only in the Apostolic Scriptures, but in the entire Bible.
