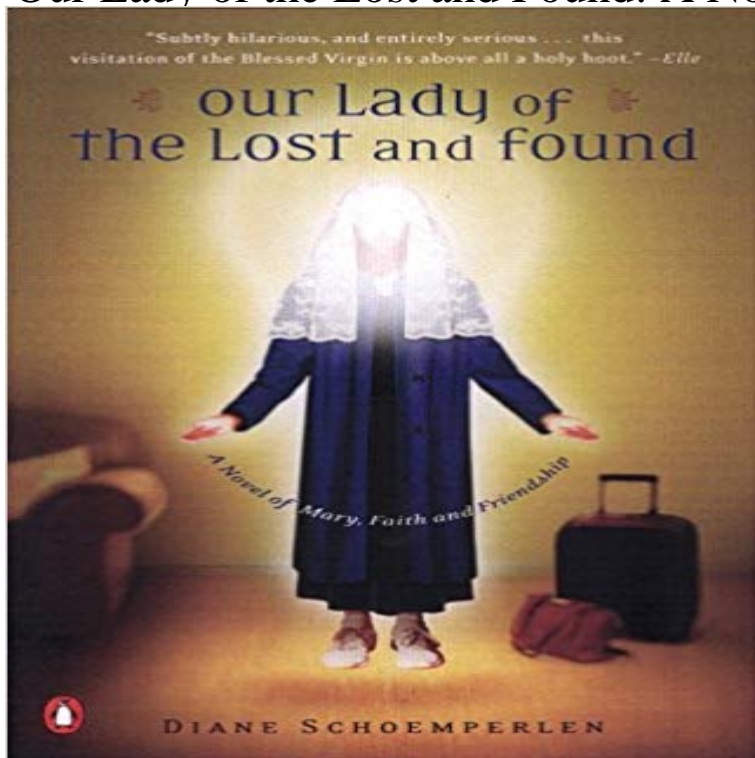


# Our Lady of the Lost and Found: A Novel of Mary, Faith, and Friendship
