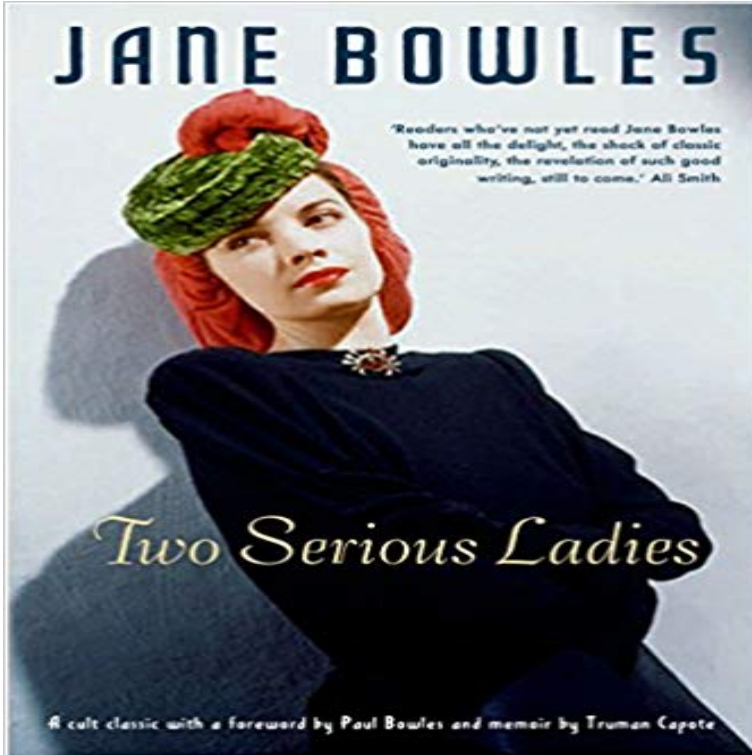


Two Serious Ladies
